



Stalking Incident Log & UT Resources

If you are the victim of stalking, it can be critical to maintain a log of stalking related incidents and behavior, especially if you choose to engage with the criminal or civil justice systems. If you wish to report incidents that occurred on UT owned property to the police, please call us at 865.974.3114. For incidents that occurred off of UT property, contact the local law enforcement agency with jurisdiction over that area. Clarification of UT property can be found [here](#). Recording this information will help document the behavior for order of protection applications, or criminal prosecution. It may also add to preserve your memory of individual incidents which you may later have to report or testify on.

The stalking log should be used to record and document all stalking related behavior- including harassing phone calls, or call attempts, text messages, letters, internet communications, acts of vandalism, and threats communicated through third parties. When reporting the incidents to law enforcement, be sure to document the officer's name, badge number, and police report number.

Optionally, attach a photograph of the offender, photocopies of any police reports, copy of the order of protection, or other relevant documentation. Keep the log in a safe place and tell only someone you trust where you keep your log.

Documenting stalking behavior can be a difficult and emotionally exhausting task. There are numerous campus resources available to help navigate your options.
